

FOOTHILL-CITRUS FOOTBALL OFFICIALS ASSOCIATION
PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE BY-LAWS

The following changes are necessary to enable the association to be re-accredited by the state CIF. These are additions to our existing By-Laws.

ADD TO: Article IV, Section 6 (d): Duties of the Secretary/Treasurer – He shall obtain and pay for a policy of Director & Officer Liability Insurance for the association with a 1,000,000 limit.

ADD TO: Article III, Section 3 (a) Certified Member Duties –

Add a new subsection: (vi) every member shall attend a minimum of 18 hours of instruction including classroom and pre-season scrimmage.

Re-number current subsection (vi) to (vii) and change the number of required meetings from 6 to 7.

Add a new subsection: (viii) work a preseason scrimmage, unless a makeup meeting is attended in place of the scrimmage.

Re-number current subsections (vii) and (viii) to account for the above insertions

ADD NEW: Article III, Section 11: Liability Insurance Coverage – every member shall annually sign a declaration stating they have purchased liability insurance covering their duties as a member, or will sign a waiver of liability and indemnification of the association. The waiver will be in form and content provided by the association. Member will further provide a copy of said policy to the association upon request.

ADD NEW: Article XI: Conflict of Interest – In addition to the restrictions of Article IV, Section 1, Article V section 2 and Article VII Section 2 of these By-Laws, the following shall be considered as a conflict of interest and therefore, without the consent and approval of the Board of Directors, the assignor shall not assign and the member shall not officiate any contest in which a participating school is,

- (a) Where the member is a graduate of within the last 5 years
- (b) The member has an immediate family member in attendance
- (c) The member or an immediate family member is an employee

The Board of Directors shall retain the right to declare additional items as also being a conflict on an individual basis.

ADDITIONAL CHANGES - These changes are grammatical in nature and or correct numbering errors.

Article III, Section 3 (b)(i)

insert the word “all” to read, Satisfy “**all**” the requirements
correctthe reference to Section 2 should read Section 3

Article III, Section 7,

Correct the reference to Section 2, should read Section 3

Re-number Article XI to XII

Correct a conflict in the by-laws – Article III Section 5, Membership Dues

Should read “amount of annual membership are recommended by the Secretary/Treasurer and Ratified by the Board of Directors” This would bring it in line with other sections of the by laws.
